Parthenocarpic Beit-alpha Type

DISCRIPTION:

Fruit:

- Number of fruit/node: 1-2 fruits+ lateral shoot.
- Multi-pistillated flowers variety.
- Shape: cylindrical.
- Length: 15-16 cm.
- Fruit Neck: No

Plant:

- Vigor: strong to medium.
- Internodes: medium to short.
- Side shoots: indeterminate lateral shoot.
- Leaves size: medium.

PRODUCTION SLOT:

- Strong to medium plant, well adapted to indoor production during winter season.

RESISTANCE:

The variety has tolerances to Px (Powdery Mildew), Cuc (Scab), CVYV (Cucumber Vein Yellowing Virus) and CMV (Cucumber Mosaic Virus).

ADVANTAGES:

- Medium plant, with indeterminate lateral shoots that produce large quantities of fruits.
- Well adapted to winter plantations in MENA region.
- Uniform fruit, cylindrical, medium green shiny color and clearly ribbed with nice shoulders.
- High yield potential of uniform and nice fruit quality.
